ACTIVITIES

-Mention at least five idiomatic uses of the verb To Be.

-Find out the definitions of the following words: WORD, PHRASE, SENTENCE AND PARAGRAPH. Be sure you understand and differentiate each of these terms very well. Based on the phrases at the end of page 15, write a complete sentence by using each of these phrases. Later you must use these same phrases to write a paragraph. Then, continue with the activities below programmed to be worked by 11 B.

Read the text titled **"The Great Whitewashing"** on pages 17 to 21. Be sure to find out all the unknown vocabulary and proceed to answer the questions related to both parts of the text. Give long answers.

Search on the internet (be sure to consult reliable and serious sites) what a PLOT is and what a SUMMARY is, Which the differences between these ones are and the steps that must be followed in order to write each of these.

Having understood what a Plot is and what a summary is, proceed to write the plot of the reading **"Two Thanksgiving Day Gentlemen"** (4 to 6 lines) and the Summary of the story **"The Great Whitewashing"** (15 to 22 lines). These exercises must be written in your notebook.
