Grammar reference: FIRST CONDITIONAL

The first conditional indicates the possibility that a situation will happen in the future and is used to predict possible actions or possible consequences and to give suggestions. It has two parts: The main clause which expresses the consequence and the subordinate clause, introduced by If or when, that expresses a hypothesis. The subordinate clause can precede or follow the main one.

If clause	Main clause	Complete sentence
If we use cotton bags,	we will reduce pollution	If we use cotton bags, we will reduce pollution
When I get a job,	I'll have more money	When I get a job, I'll have more money

In English the verb in the main clause is always in the future simple, while the verb in the subordinate clause is always in the present simple.
